WHAT TO EXPECT

Upon your arrival, our nursing team will complete an initial assessment and obtain vitals. An inventory sheet needs to be completed for your clothing and personal items upon admission. Please ensure all items are logged and updated throughout your stay.

Within 72 hours, you will meet with several members of the Administrative Team. During these brief meetings, the team will explain several important aspects of your stay, such as:

- Expected length of stay
- Medications and treatment
- Primary/secondary payors
- Therapy goals
- Discharge planning process
- Advanced Directives
- Care Plan Meetings

YOUR ATTENDING PHYSICIAN

During your stay, your skilled needs will be cared for by Buchanan Place's medical team of RNs, LPNs, Social Workers and Therapists. Your care will be overseen by our Medical Director, Dr. Debusk and Buchanan's Certified Nurse Practitioner. Dr. Debusk will complete an initial comprehensive assessment, assist in care plan development, periodically review care plan goals, and ensure the appropriate diagnostic tests are performed.

A medical practitioner will see you within 72 hours of admit; you will then receive one doctor visit every 30 days, unless additional visits are needed. Please note that the Attending Physician and Certified Nurse Practitioner will remain on call throughout your entire stay, in case of emergency.

MEDICATIONS

Once you have arrived and your hospital orders have been clarified, your prescriptions will be sent to our contracted pharmacy to be filled. Medications are delivered same-day to the facility, depending on the time of your arrival (medications are typically delivered to the facility 3 times per day). Please see your Nurse Supervisor regarding any questions or concerns.

THERAPY SERVICES

Therapists will be in to assess your current therapy goals and prior functioning abilities.

Your assessment will indicate the duration and frequency of the services you will receive. Depending on your assessment and/or Physician's orders, you may be



seen up to 5-6 days per week, with 1-3 sessions per day. Each session can range from 30-75 minutes. You will begin to receive your daily therapy schedule the day following your initial assessment. Schedules are also available at the Nurse's Station, and are subject to change.

DISCHARGE PLANNING

To help provide you with a safe and seamless transition home, our Social Services Director will arrange post-discharge services prior to your discharge. These services may include home health aides, therapy (in-home or outpatient), and durable medical equipment. Your length of stay will be determined by several key factors, such as your insurance benefits, nursing needs, and/or progress in therapy.

WHAT CAN I BRING?

Suggested Items:

- CD Players, CD's, mp3player, Etc.
- Dentures
- Disposable incontinence products
- Eye glasses
- Paintings, afghans, throw pillows
- Plastic framed photos
- Personal Furniture
- Toiletries
- Washable and labeled apparel (7-10 day supply) and walking shoes

Items Not

Recommended:

- Glass or breakable items
- Electric Blankets
- Excessive amounts of sweets
- Bedside Medications
- Powder
- Perishable food
- Live plants
- Power Strips
